ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

To enroll a child in North Kannapolis Christian Academy, take the following steps.

Submit the following items to the Academy office:

1. A complete application and registration fee (non-refundable).
2. An up to date immunization record is required by law before your child can start to school for the first time. These are the required immunizations:
 - 5-DPT
 - 4-Polio
 - 3-Hepatitis B
 - 2-MMR
 - 3-HIB

A physical is required for ALL students new to NKCA before the first day of school.

3. A copy of your child's birth certificate and social security card is needed at time of registration. A copy of custody documentation is needed if child is not living with both biological parents.
4. Payment of a registration fee (non-refundable) and first month tuition is required to enroll you child (ren) and hold a place in his/her assigned class.

*Note

A student must have passed the anniversary of the 5th birthday no later than August 31st of the year of matriculation to enroll in Kindergarten.
